How much are VIP Hospitality tickets?

- Thursday £75
- Friday £120
- Saturday £95
- Sunday £85

What does a ticket include?

- Exclusive marquee and viewing area
- Drink on arrival
- Two course lunch
- Afternoon cream tea
- Access to VIP bar and deck throughout the day
- Private toilets
- There may also be the opportunity to meet passing display teams who pop into the marquee for refreshments!

Are evening tickets available?

Yes - we will be running Friday 3rd & Saturday 4th September 7pm – 11pm. Evening ticket prices are £20 per person.

What are the hospitality marquee opening times?

The marquee is open 11am – 6pm for daytime ticket holders. Once evening tickets are available, the marquee will cater for evening entertainment 7pm – 11pm. Due to the number of visitors to the Air Festival event, please leave adequate time to reach the marquee.

Is there an age restriction – can children come?

Daytime Air Festival hospitality is for children aged 8yrs and over, there is however no age restriction for the evening.

How much are children's tickets?

Children aged 2yrs and over will need a ticket to attend the evening entertainment, there is no discount available and will be charged the same price as a regular ticket on both daytime and evening hospitality. Spaces are limited for children under the age of 2 yrs, please email bafhospitality@hotmail.co.uk to book any required tickets.

Where is the hospitality marquee?

Air Festival hospitality is located on the beach directly below the central flight line, providing the perfect setting to watch the stunning action. We are between Bournemouth and Boscombe Pier by lamppost number 13, approx. 100 metres from the bottom of Toff Zig Zag.

What happens if the flying schedule is changed or cancelled?

The hospitality marquee runs throughout the day regardless of any changes or cancellation of the flying schedules. In the event of changes or cancellation, no refunds will be given.

What is the dress code?

Dress code is smart casual

Where can I park?

If you have a ticket to daytime hospitality, you are able to use the park and ride free of charge. The parking locations are listed below, you will just need to show your lanyard (ticket) to gain access to the bus. Your ticket does not allow you to jump the queue so please allow adequate time.

- Kings Park (BH7 7AF) – Thursday, Friday, Saturday 9am – 11pm; Sunday 9am – 7pm
- Redhill Park (BH9 2SW) – Saturday 9am – 10.45pm; Sunday 9am – 7pm

Please note, the buses drop off at Manor Road, approx. 5-10 min walk from the event site.

What provision do you have for people requiring accessibility assistance?

The marquee has a ramp for easy access and a small buggy which can collect marquee ticket holders from Boscombe Pier. Please note, the buggy can only transport clients requiring accessibility assistance and cannot be used for their able bodied companions, it is however subject to availability and flying restrictions.
