



Responsible & sustainable festival goer – help us make our event, super safe and sustainable

- Don't take the car – be our '1 in 3' take the bus/ train/ cycle/ walk where you can and help us save a massive 2,000 tonnes of CO2 emissions
- Be prepared and 'Know before you go' visit bournemouth.co.uk/visitor-information/coronavirus
- Follow the official Air Festival social channels, check out the site in advance
- Download the Air Festival and *Beach Check apps and avoid the busy beaches areas
- When you arrive move to the middle of the beach – there's plenty of room for everyone!
- Please don't travel to the event if you have any covid symptoms
- In high footfall areas – hospitality marquee, RAF Village and the new East Overcliff Atlas Elektronik STEM area, if comfortable doing so please wear a mask/ face covering when moving around.
- Please don't bring BBQs to the beach – it's much safer to support the onsite food and drink traders or bring a picnic
- Stay fire safe and help prevent fires #bringabbqnotapicnic
- IF you see something suspicious find a Policeman, Ranger, Security officer or member of the Events Team, remember 'See it, Say it, Sorted'.
- Be warned - if you're coming by car, please park responsibly in a car park or only in marked bays, there is a tow away system in place!
- *WARNING* drones are strictly not allowed to be flown at the event site, please do not bring them to the festival. It's against the law to fly them within the Restricted Air Festival Airspace established to protect participating aircraft and display teams. Organisers are under strict rules to cancel the flying display programme if drones are flying in the dedicated approved air space; drone operators will be prosecuted
